This is the income that a family needs for a decent living and that keeps them out of poverty in the face of adversity. Living income includes expenses for meals, housing, education, clothing, medical care, transport and cultural events. Living income is measured in every project area, because circumstances differ between, and even within countries.

With support of Heifer the lives of farming families are improved. The main focus is increasing income (Profit). But only if you take into account the People and the Planet, can you improve lives in the long term. With this vision, Heifer supports farming families to grow from subsistence farming to producing for the market. These families have an income that keeps them out of poverty when experiencing setbacks. Next, there are sufficient nutritious meals for the family, women have a voice in decision-making at the household and community level, there is solidarity and collaboration in the community and climate-smart techniques are applied.
